

Tallahassee Youth USBC Guidelines for Establishing Hall of Fame

1. The purpose of the Hall of Fame committee shall be to perpetuate the names of those who have displayed outstanding ability in the sport of American Tenpins and/or have contributed meritorious service to the reputation and progress of bowling in the area served by the Tallahassee USBC Association.
2. The hall of fame shall be an official function of the Tallahassee USBC Association, and membership in the hall of fame shall be determined by annual election.
3. The Hall of Fame Committee is appointed by the president with approval by the board, and should consist of the following:
 - 2 Members of the board
 - 1 Youth Director or 1 Youth Board Director
 - 1 Hall of Fame membersThe association president is an ex-officio member of the Hall of Fame Committee
4. Candidate Qualifications:

A point system will be used to avoid making a selection based on bias or without supporting documentation. An individual must accumulate 50 or more point to qualify.

5. Bowling Achievement:

- ____ Participated in TUSBC Tournaments (1 point each per year)
- ____ Number of seasons with a 185 or above average men – Women 170 (5 points per yr.)
- ____ Number of 700 Series men – 600 series women (3 points each)
- ____ Number of 300 GAMES BOWLED (10 point per game)
- ____ NUMBER of 279-299 GAMES BOWLED (5 points per game)

6. Meritorious Service:

- ____ Director (6 points per year)
 - ____ Association Manager (4 points per year)
 - ____ Years of Bowling (1 point per year)
 - ____ Association Volunteer (1 point per year)
- TOTAL POINTS _____

7. Nominations:

- Any member of TUSBC Association may submit nominations, along with the nominee’s qualifications and achievements to the association president or association manager.
8. Nominees may be selected for living or posthumously members.
 9. The selections shall consist of no more than 2 nominees per year.
